The second track from Sacre Noir's forthcoming third LP is an uplifting mix of electronica and house with a topping of female vocals and live guitars. A Rhythm Between Work and Sleep was inspired by a quote from George Orwell's 1933 book 'Down and Out in Paris and London' which documents the author's struggles living rough in two of the world's greatest cities.

The track's lyrics speak of themes including poverty, drudgery and the dislocation of workers in large modern cities and the accompanying video features imagery playing on these themes. Filmed on location at The Biscuit Factory in Edinburgh the video was conceived by the band in collaboration with make-up artist Erin Culley and actors Lyndsey Buchanan and Emma Thorburn.

The video will be availlable on the Sacre Noir YouTube page after midnight on the 1st July 2016 and the track will be included on the third album Nothing Falls Apart, to be released on the 1st August 2016.
