After some great responses to the live shows in Paris, London, Berlin and Edinburgh in 2011, it was decided that 'She Can't Take It' would be the first single released from the forthcoming 2nd album by Sacre Noir. Staying true to the haunting, lo-fi atmospheric sounds now synonymous with Sacre Noir, this single manages to capture the live style too & draws on more up-beat influences than those found on the debut album 'Her Volatile Condition'.

UK release date: 13th May 2012

A bass / synth driven track with gritty guitar sounds, 'She Can't Take It' is a catchy slice of electro-pop, that grabs your attention at the intro.

After a great show in Goldman's Bar (Berlin) on a very cold night in December 2011, one lovely and lively Londoner declared after the gig, "you've got to do a video for that track" She was clearly a creative type finding it hard to leave her work at home in Brick Lane, but was totally convinced that a video was a good move.
