

Third installment of lo-fi electronica from solo Scottish female artist

Introducing the third installment of lo-fi electronica from Edinburgh based **Sacre Noir**. Having received excellent reviews for the previous releases in this trilogy of home recordings, **demo recordings III** does not disappoint... Collaborating with Canadian artist **D.Soul the Soulsamurai** (on 'I'll do what you want just don't ask me to smile') and members of the **savage sound system** (on 'Up Again'), this EP retains the haunting atmospheric and layered vocal style that has become the defining characteristics of **Sacre Noir**.

Starting in 2003 as a studio project **Sacre Noir** has previously released 2 EPs, **demo recordings** (2005) and **demo recordings II** (2006). The track 'A Mescaline Monologue' was picked up by Japanese **breakbeat/electronica** label **Dejine:Rec** and Italian Video Label **Zerofeedback**. Remixes and collaborations have been plentiful; **NON (Exceptional Records UK)**, **!S.A.Dj! (Italy)**, **D.Soul the Soulsamurai (Canada)** and many more...

Sacre Noir has performed live as part of the **savage sound system** collective and plans to bring together a live set drawn from the 3 **demo recordings** EPs. All 3 recordings are available from **Avalanche Records** and online from the **savage recordings** store, or by request via the **Sacre Noir** website.
